Non-NCCP Certified Coach Exemption - \$199.95
Certification Exemption Request - \$200.00 (one time fee)

Applicants must be **age of majority**.

Licensed Coach Status applicants must have validated and recognized expertise through any of the following:

- Coaching Certification, **or**
- Recognized formal training, **or**
- Post-secondary equine education, **or**
- 15+ years of coaching experience.

If you hold NCCP coach certification, your record will be automatically recorded in your ECampus

If you are applying based on 15+years of coaching experience, you are required to complete a Certification Exemption Form upon coach status enrollment. Please note there is a one time processing fee of \$200 for Certification Exemption.

Current First Aid Certification

- Standard First Aid Certification, provided by a recognized Canadian First Aid provider

3. Screening Requirements

- Canadian Criminal Record Check (no charge to Coach Status applicants through Sterling BackCheck once coach status enrollment is complete)
- If you have lived outside of Canada in the last 10 years, international screening is required and there will be an additional fee of \$100. EC will initiate the screening request upon payment.
- Vulnerable Sector Search (required only if you were born before January 1, 1986)
- Two Letters of Reference

4. Insurance Requirements

- Certificate of Insurance with minimum coverage of;
 - \$2,000,000 General Liability and
 - \$100,000 Professional Liability coverage,



- Equestrian Canada and your Provincial/Territorial Equestrian Association must be named as additional insured
- Waiver of subrogation in favor of Equestrian Canada and your Provincial/Territorial Equestrian Association.
